

# INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE STUDENTS

## ACCOMODATION IN A HALLOF RESIDENCE

**Caution:** As the number of rooms is limited, all the students might not be able to be accommodated in a hall of residence.

#### Types of room

	COMFORT ROOM	ECONOMIC ROOM

SURFACE	9 to 12 m <sup>2</sup>	9 m²
RENT includes water and electricity charges	244 €	165 €

Sheets and blankets are provided on request by the residence. Pillows and kitchen tools must be provided by the student.

#### Availability of the room depending on mobilitytype

Mobility for the academic year	1st September 2020 to 31st May 2021
Mobility during the first semester	1st September to 31st December 2020
Mobility during the second semester	1st January 1 to May 31st, 2021

Rooms in hall of residence are booked for the entire semester or academic year. Booking dates cannot be changed. Please refer to specific cases\*.

**Caution:** The first month must be fully paid even if you arrive after the first month (i.e. September for the  $1^{st}$  semester or January for the  $2^{nd}$  semester).

<sup>\*</sup>You can <u>request an extension</u> of your booking only for academic reasons (i.e. exams taking place in January) and according to the availability in your hall of residence.

<sup>\*</sup>In case of **early departure** during the semester, you must notify the hall of residence 30 days before the departure date. Otherwise you will be charged for the whole month.

### Answers to accommodation booking requests

Arrivals during the first semester	June / early July
Arrivals during the second semester	November / early December

The accommodation assignment is carried out by the Université de Rennes 1 according to availability. If your housing request is confirmed, you will receive a confirmation email including a <u>letter of assignment</u>. This document will be requested on the day of your arrival at the hall of residence.

It will not be possible to request a change of hall of residence.

Caution: All cancellations must be reported to the International Affairs Department as soon as possible and no later than August 24. Contact address: dari-entrant@univ-rennes1.fr

#### **Documents to be provided**

<sup>\*</sup>In France, a multi-risk home insurance is mandatory. This policy can be subscribed online. Make sure that it includes civil liability as well.

#### Arrival at the residence

Hall of residence - opening hours of the welcome desk: Monday to Friday from 9am to 4pm.

<u>If your arrival is scheduled out of these hours</u>, you must inform the Hall of Residence welcome desk in advance of your arrival day and time (the e-mail address is indicated on the letter of assignment you have received) and the International Affairs Department (DARI).

When you arrive, you will be asked to pay the first month's rent and a security deposit (i.e. 1 month's rent). The security deposit will be returned to you at the end of your stay within two months (if no damage has been noticed).

**Caution:** Only credit card payment is allowed (no cash will be accepted by the hall of residence). Please make sure that your **payment limit** will allow both the payment of your rent and your security deposit.

<sup>\*</sup>Students who are not part of the Erasmus programme" will have to provide a Deed of personal surety: you can make a request online via the VISALE system (visale.fr). This warranty is however, only available for students under 31 years old. **Erasmus** + **students** are **exempt from this requirement**.
