b) Copy of Passport

- d) Letter of Recommendation
- e) 3x4 cm Photo

Once accepted, students must submit the following documents:

a) Student Visa

b) Enrollment Certificate issued by the home institution

c) The international student must obtain an international health insurance plan covering medical/dental care or a national health insurance plan covering medical/dental care upon arrival in Brazil.

> Language Requirements

Most courses are offered in Portuguese, with the exception of the following subjects:
