ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Must have completed at least one year of university study and come from one of our UST partner universities
- Official transcripts from all institutions attended
- Minimum cumulative GPA: 2.5
- Applicants whose native language is not English must meet one of the following minimum requirements as proof of English proficiency:
 - 213 TOEFL CBT
 - 79 TOEFL IBT
 - 550 TOEFL ITP
 - 6.5 IELTS
 - 125 Duolingo English Test
 - other acceptable test score mutually agreed upon

(Please note that not all courses are available every semester)

Minimum enrollment for undergraduate exchange students is 12 credit hours, and 9 for graduate students. Exchange students can only take one online course each semester.

The following program courses are not available for exchange students: Air Force Science, General Business, Networking, Cyber Security, Exceptionality, any AAS courses, Military Science, Nursing, Health Simulation, Reading/Education/Special Education, General Science, Drug/Alcohol Counseling.

Courses with a number starting with 5 or above are graduate courses and are not available to undergraduate students.

VISA AND IMMIGRATION

International exchange students studying in the U.S. must obtain the J-1 Exchange Visitor visa, unless already a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident.

Upon acceptance into your academic program, an OISSA Advisor will provide further information on what documents are needed for Form DS-2019 issuance. You will need the Form DS-2019 in order to apply for the J-1 Visa.
